ESTEC – Schiphol Airport

A one-way voucher € 13.50.

The driver of the shuttle bus gives the traveler a voucher which serves as a receipt.

Vouchers may be purchased on the bus, however, in order to minimize the waiting time, it is desirable to purchase them before at the ESTEC reception located in the A building. At this moment payment with credit card is not possible.

Several vouchers may be purchased beforehand, yet they can be claimed as travel cost when they are actually used on a mission.

What is the course duration?

The Course will last for a week and starts on Monday April 18th at 9 am, so it is advisable to spend the night before in the area.

The schedule is as follows:

Monday April 18th: 9:00-13:00 and 14:00-18:00
Tuesday April 19th: 9:00-13:00 and 14:00-17:30
Wednesday April 20th: 9:00-13:00 and 14:00-17:30
Thursday April 21st: 9:00-13:15 and 14:15-18:00
Friday April 22nd: 9:00-13:00 and 14:00-17:00

In addition, on Monday 18th, it is planning a Welcome Cocktail at 18:00 to 19:30, and on Thursday 21st at 19:00 a Social Dinner that is included in the registration fee.

The Course will extend for one week (37 hours) and, because the Course will have a final assessment test, it will provide 3.7 ECTS to the students. A brief description of the course contents and teaching staff will be attached to the official certificate, in order to ease its recognition as free-choice credits of European Universities official Master and PhD programs (i.e. courses offered by the European School of Antennas have already got it).

Who can register for the course?

Course participants may be researchers and engineers from all Universities, as well as Research and Technological Centers. Industry participants can register too.



Who can register as a student or EuMA member?

Those participants who are students or EuMA members. Both have a discount on the registration fee for the course.

To be registered as such, proof will be required to verify these conditions, like EuMA affiliation number or any document from EuMA in order to prove your membership; or an official student registration certificate or certificate tuition fee, or any statement of the University which indicates that you are a student there.

How the awarding of grants will work?

Up to 3 PhD students will get the registration fee granted. Applicants should send their CV to mababel@iteam.upv.es

After closing the registration period and after evaluate the applications received, we will announce 3 awarded grants that will not have to pay the associated registration fee.

You need to register in the course for being taken into account in the selection process.
